



The ERASMUS+ eTwinning project started on 1st September 2020.

In accordance with the written application decisions were taken and actions were carried out from the beginning of the project:

- A first online meeting of professors partners in September 2020 to define the tasks and objectives of the beginning of the project;
- The presentation of the students on the Glide application;
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- The presentation of the countries on Genial.ly by the students of the various partner schools;
- The presentation of the cities on Genial.ly by the students of the partner schools;
- The presentation of the partner schools on Genial.ly by the students of the different partner schools;
- Erasmus day with a cup-stacking challenge between the partners;
- An online meeting of partner professors in November 2020 to prepare an online meeting of students in December;
- An online meeting of students in December 2020 with 10 activities chosen collectively by the partners:
 - Proposals for project logo and choice of Logo by vote of students;
 - decoding game with the DecodeMe app: the hidden message to decode is "How to reduce plastic wastes? Share your ideas with us";
 - Answergarden collaborative word cloud on solutions to reduce plastic;
 - videos and Tactileo questionnaire on the problem of plastic waste in 3 parts;
 - Creation of recycled or re-used plastic objects;
 - Virtual tour of institutions Jeu final Kahoot en ligne.

For the month of January 2021:

- Several teachers participating in the project are on holiday (Reunion Island) or in distance classes or in regular classes (with health protection instructions).
- Activities of the December 2020 online meeting remain to be completed, such as the challenge of re-using plastic waste: Once the students' constructions are finalized, an online exhibition and a vote of the best idea will be organized.
- the diagnostic assessment questionnaire is to be completed by all students;
- The Netiquette is to be defined collaboratively with the students. This Netiquette must set the rules for the proper use of ICT tools and good communication between participants;
- New colleagues have joined the project (Carole, Sylvaine, Nadine, Stéfanie et Gediminas) ;
- The 1st physical meeting may be held at the end of August in Paris, depending on international health conditions. This meeting would allow the partners to meet in a city that is easy to access for all, and above all to work on the program of the 2nd year of the project with the possibility of organizing face-to-face meetings with the students.
