



GOOGLE MEET CHAT MINUTES 2021, FEBRUARY 19th, 6pm CET

1/ A quick tour of the sanitary and teaching conditions in the different countries showed that most of the partners is still teaching online and/or with a short presence at schools with students, except in France where the lessons are normally held but with masks. Working conditions are very changing due to sanitary crisis and the situation is expected to change in the coming weeks.

2/ Project activities for the months of March and April: The list of activities is validated by the group:

- Artistic photos of wastes with smartphones filters, color effects and free ICT tools like PIXLR. A gallery of the photos will be done with Padlet at the end of the activity;
- « Turtles journey » video (in collaboration with Greenpeace) with a Tactileo modules and slogans on billboards created by the students;
- Comics creation with a learning workshop (on line and registered) with a professional drawer/illustrator, and international teams of students to build storyboards and create comics about wastes problems;
- Giant plastic sculptures with plastics collected in the schools, and creation of a giant sculpture in every school, in order to recycle the plastics at the end of the activity;
- Frédérique explains the project of the sailboat skipper Yvan BOURGNON about collecting wastes and plastics in the oceans. Frédérique already talked to Y.BOURGNON and will try to make us join this interesting project;

3/ 2nd virtual meeting with students: The next online meeting with students will take place in May or in June, (according to the scholar calendars of the different partners). The program of the meeting has been discussed and it has been decided to organize a digital presentation of the artistic creations with as materials collected plastics, a digital presentation of the creations of comics, a challenge of collecting plastic bottle caps (except in countries where bottles are fully returnable like in Lithuania). Zuzana proposed a challenge on the different waste collection processes in the partner countries. The idea is very interesting and will be developed for the meeting. She will propose her ideas in the next week.

4/ August teachers' meeting: The idea of a teachers' meeting at the end of August is confirmed, as the sanitary conditions would be favorable. This meeting will take place over 4 days, from August 24th to 28th in Paris. In a few weeks, Estelle and Sébastien will offer hotel accommodation and a programmation with 2 working session on the morning and also cultural visits. The meeting would take place during the summer holidays (except for Frederique, Reunion island starts lessons after the 15h of August). Each partner can feel free to come alone or accompanied by colleagues or members of his family (of course not on the budget go the project).

Frédérique proposed the very interesting idea of contact associations or institutions working on the waste problem in Paris for working sessions and sharing ideas.

5/ eTwinning project quality label: The eTwinning project associated with the Erasmus project will be the subject of a quality label application in June. A joint application will be written for all the participants. The same for the eTwinning prize.

6/ The work on Netiquette has to be finished next week, there's several students' propositions and a summary will be done and post on the eTwinning twinspace page.

7/ Conclusion: Once again this online meeting shows the dynamism and seriousness of our team and the willingness to find solutions to continue to move forward despite the health difficulties and the impossibility to meet currently. It is a great satisfaction for all of us.
