



Les Abymes, Guadeloupe, 2022, June, 3-7 Erasmus+ « What a waste! » meeting minutes

Summary of the last meeting of partner teachers, at Baimbridge High School, June 3-7, 2022:

The meeting began on Friday, June 3, at Baimbridge High School, with an escape-game, with questions related to events held during the project, about Baimbridge High School and the discovery of the Guadeloupe archipelago. The teachers participating in the meeting were thus able to get to know each other in this team-building activity;

On the same Friday, June 3, a ceremony of presentation of European eTwinning labels was held for the Guadeloupean students who participated in the project in 2021 by Canopé.

On Saturday, June 4, after the visit of the new Baimbridge High School, the colleagues were received at the town hall of Abymes for a presentation of the city's environmental and waste management policy. This presentation was very much appreciated and is entirely part of the Erasmus project.

On Sunday, June 5, the partners were able to discover the exceptional environment and the fragile ecosystem of the Grand-Cul-de-Sac Marine, by boat. The visit was commented and explained by a local fisherman. The partners were made aware of the delicate balance of this particular ecosystem protected by the coral reef and mangrove.

Monday, June 6 (holiday) was dedicated to the visit of the Saints and its protected and specific natural setting.

On Tuesday 7 June, the partners participated in the writing of the final report of the project, taking stock of the physical and virtual meetings, the activities developed throughout the project, and important points to highlight.

A small closing ceremony of the meeting was then held, with a last friendly meal in the refectory of the Baimbridge high school in the presence of the management staff.
